- Most airlines now charge a fee per checked bag (contact the airline to verify the policy about checked bags)
- Check the airline's website 24 hours before departure to verify the flight time
- Arrive at the airport 3 hours prior to departure for an international flight (2 hours prior for a domestic flight)



PASSPORTS & VISAS (INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL)

All travellers should:

- Verify that your passport is valid by confirming that the expiration date is at least 6 months after your trip
- Verify that you have the appropriate visa(s) if required (for example, a visa is required to enter in China and must be issued by the Chinese embassy)

MONEY

All travellers should:

- Have at least \$100 of local currency upon arrival (the group will go to a money exchange; however, we
 recommend bringing enough local currency for the first day of arrival)
- Have a recommended \$30 \$35 of pocket money per day in small denominations
- Contact your bank or credit union to inform them that you will be using the card abroad (this will help to avoid a stop being placed on the card due to unusual activity)
- Confirm with your bank that your ATM card can be used in your destination
- Bring a VISA or MasterCard if you wish to bring a credit card since these are the most widely accepted

TIPPING

- Tips for your Tour Director(s), Tour Guides, and Drivers are not included in the cost of your trip (please reference the chart below for recommended tips)
- Group Leaders and chaperones are encouraged to tip if they appreciate the service provided on the tour
- Other service providers who would appreciate tips are transfer drivers, hotel porters, and local guides

TELEPHONING

- If you wish to use a personal cell phone, verify with your service provider that your phone will be operational in your destination (check the associated costs per minute as these are typically VERY expensive)
- Using telephone cards purchased from newsstands and convenience stores is generally easier and less
 expensive than using a personal cell phone
